On motion of Mr. Brown,

It was amended as follows:

In the 5th and 6th sections where the words severally occur "who shall act in the execution of this law" insert the words "in locating the said line mentioned in the first section of this act."

Insert as the 8th and 9th sections:

Sec. 8, And be it enacted, That Richard Hooker, Micajah Rogers and Benj. Bennett, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to fix and establish the following as a part of the line between Baltimore and Carroll counties, to wit—beginning on the Western branch of Patapsco river, (the same river being the dividing line between Anne Arundel and Carroll counties) at a Ford known by the name of Hipdey's ford, and running thence along the road leading from said Ford to Stephen's lane, and along said lane to the North end thereof, thence in a straight line to the Baltimore and Liberty town road, to intersect the same opposite a lane on the hill below the Methodist church near Freedom, thence in a straight line to the mouth of Little Morgan's run, and thence to a ford on the north branch of Patapsco river, (the dividing line between Carroll and Baltimore counties) opposite Gassies' factory, (formerly Cockey's mill,) where a road running from the Deer Park road to Reisterstown now crosses said stream; and to bound said line by marking trees, and planting or causing to be planted large and sufficient boundary-stones, so as clearly to designate the above named and prescribed line, and to certify their proceedings to Baltimore county court and to Carroll county court; and it shall be the duty of the clerks of those courts to record the same at the cost of their respective counties.

Sec. 9: And be it enacted, That all the expenses attending the location of said line, between Baltimore county and Carroll county, shall be levied upon, and paid by Baltimore county as other county charges are levied and paid.

The bill was then read through, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
