Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Brown from the committee on internal improvement to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the St. Martin's canal and navigation company, reported favorably thereon,

On motion of Mr. Brown,

It was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Purnell from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the appointment of commissioners and the division of Worcester county into school districts, and for other purposes,

Which was read the first and by special order, the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Jones,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Kent from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Benjamin G. Coale former sheriff of St. Mary's county, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought not to pass,

It was read the second and by special order the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.
