The bill entitled an additional supplement to the act entitled an act, respecting hay and straw brought for sale to the city of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Cottman,

The bill entitled an act in aid of the construction of a state armory and town hall in the city of Baltimore, and the rebuilding and improvement of the Hanover market house in said city,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Schley from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled a supplement to the act entitled an act to provide for building a court house in Montgomery county, passed at December session 1835, chapter 164, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled an act relating to appeals,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled a supplement to an act entitled an act to authorise the levy court of Kent county to condemn a lot of land for the purpose of making a causeway or dam over the narrows at eastern neck island, and to appoint commissioners to make a contract for the making of said dam or causeway over the said narrows at or near the place where the bridge crosses the said narrows in the county aforesaid,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wright, Goldsborough and Hambleton.

A bill entitled a supplement to the act to incorporate the farmers and millers bank of Hagerstown,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.
