It was read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Beckett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled a further supplement to the act to authorise the governor and council to build a new tobacco inspection wars house in the city of Baltimore, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment;

Which was read assented to,

Strike out the second section of the bill,

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates

Mr. Jones from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled an act relating to mortgages in the city of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

It was being read the second time, when,

On motion of Mr. Schley,

It was committed to the committee on judicial proceed-

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The bill entitled an act to incorporate the Annapolis and Elkridge Rail Road Company, was taken up for consideration,

It was be ng read the third time, when

On motion of Mr. Schley,

It was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Kent from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled a supplement to the act to regulate the manner of obtaining and altering public roads in this State, passed January 26, 1819, reported favorably thereon,

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The resolution in favor of the chief and assistant elerk of the house of delegates,

Was read the third time by special order, dissented

from and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Goldsborough from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled an act to authorise the sale of certain parts of the real and personal estate of the late Nicholas Hammond of Talbot county, deceased, and con-
