

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brown, Jones and Hilleary.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate entitled an additional supplement to the act entitled an act to incorporate the Canton company of Baltimore, endorsed "will pass."

Also returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled an act relating to the form in which promissory notes may be given to the incorporated banks of this State, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment,"

Which amendment was read and adopted, and was as follows:

In the 1st section 3d line after the word "notes" insert the word "hereafter."

Mr Brown from the committee on pensions, to which was referred the bill entitled an act relating to pensions by county assessment in Carroll county, and,

The bill entitled an act for the benefit of Henry Boyer and Mary Carlin of Frederick county, reported favorably thereon,

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Schley from the committee to which was committed the bill entitled an act relating to mortgages in the city of Baltimore, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and dissented from.

In the third line of the bill of the 1st section, strike out after the word "to," the words "the mortgagee or."

In the same line, after word "person;" insert "than the mortgagee."

In the 14th section, (page 4,) line 5, after the word "executed," strike out the words "by the mortgagee upon such sale."

In the 16th section, 2d line, strike out the words "and an assignment of the mortgage shall always operate as an assignment of the power to sell whereon a power shall have been given to the mortgagee."

The bill was then read through the second and by special order the third time, and the question put,

"Shall the bill pass?"
