stitution, and how far the several mechanical employments there prosecuted interfere with the mechanics of Baltimore, or other parts of the State: and that the committee report the result of their examination, together with such testimony as they may collect, and such suggestions as mey grow out of it, for the improvement of the institution and the interest of the State, to the next General Assembly—and have appointed Messrs. Bowlus, Maulsby and Tuck, on the part of this house, to meet such gentlemen as may be named by you, to compose said committee.
