

Resolution sent to the house of delegates requesting the Governor to issue a commission in the usual form, to the Honorable John S. Spence, as Senator to represent this State in the Congress of the United States, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the death of the late Honorable Robert H. Goldsborough 32.

Message received from the house of delegates proposing to proceed to the election of the Governor, and nominating Thomas W. Veazey 37, message returned concurring, election had 38.

Message sent to the house of delegates proposing that a joint committee of the two houses be sent to notify the Governor of his election, and requesting his attendance to qualify, message received concurring 42, report of committee 43-4, Governor elect attends and qualifies 48.

Message received from, containing a report of the Directors of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, a statement of the Directors of the Penitentiary, a report of the Superintendent of that part of the National Road, within the limits of this State, a letter from the Honorable Richard H. Wilde, of Georgia, in relation to the library of the late Count Bontourlin, and a letter from Dr. James Mease, relative to the composition of a Gazetteer of this State 68.

Message from, covering a report and resolutions passed by the Legislature of Georgia, on the subject of the Surplus Revenue of the United States, proposed to be deposited among the States, referred to the consideration of the house of delegates 114.

Message received from, with report of the commissioners appointed to make a reconnaissance and survey, and to estimate the cost of a rail road on the Eastern Shore, with two reports of the Chief Engineer employed by the commissioners, to make
