

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on revolutionary claims.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Bank of Maryland,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations and joint stock companies.

A bill entitled, an act declaratory of the law concerning contempts of court in this state,

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise the Franklin Rail Road Company incorporated by the State of Pennsylvania, to extend their works within the limits of the State of Maryland, endorsed "will pass."

Also returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to confirm an act entitled, an act to alter and amend the constitution and form of government so as to require the assent of two-thirds of each branch of the Legislature to annul a marriage contract, endorsed "will not pass."

On motion of Mr. Purnell,

The bill entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of Samuel Polk of Somerset county, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Jones,

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hambleton from the committee on divorces, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to divorce Sarah Anne Sears of Calvert county, from her husband Robert Sears, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning, 10 o'clock.
