Ordered, That the Committee of Grievances and Courts of Justice enquire into the expediency of reporting a bill, compelling the Justice of the several Justices' Courts in this State, in any and all cases in which real estate may be sold by virtue of any process issued by said court, to place in the hands of the clerks of the several county courts, all papers and proceedings in any manner relating to said sale, to be recorded.

Mr. Alexander, chairman of the committee on ways and means, delivered the following reports.

The Committee of Ways and Means to whom was referred the memorial of the Commissioners of the Real Estate Bank of Baltimore, praying to be allowed to go into operation with a capital of five hundred thousand dollars, have had the subject under consideration, and ask to be discharged from the further consideration of the same.
