The house then resumed the consideration of the order of the day, being the bill, entitled, an act to confirm an act, entitled, an act for the division of Baltimore and Frederick counties, and for erecting a new one by the name of "Carroll," and to alter and change the Constitution of this State, so far as may be necessary to effect the same, passed at December session 1835, chap. 256.

After some time spent in debate,

Mr. Ely moved that the House adjourn;

Resolved in the affirmative.
