Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Richardson, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Gibson, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband John Gibson;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time;

Mr. Crisfield, moved to lay said bill on the table;

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Alexander moved to lay the bill on the table,

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred, and was put, shall the said bill pass,

Resolved in the affirmative,

And the bill sent to the senate.

The clerk of the senate, delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the senate, entitled, an act to authorise the Franklin Rail Road Company, incorporated by the State of Pennsylvania, to extend their works within the limits of the State of Maryland,

Which was read and referred to the committee on internal improvement;

And, a petition of Henry Baer, of Frederick county, a soldier of the revolution, praying to be placed on the pension roll, endorsed "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates,"

Which was read and referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims,

The House resumed the consideration of the unfinished business of yesterday, being the resolutions submitted by Mr. Alexander, on the 10th instant, in relation to authorising the Governor and Council in their discretion, to employ additional counsel to aid the Attorney General in the defence of the suit now pending between the city of Baltimore and Robert Lemmon, one of the Auctioneers in said city,
