Mr. Richardson, then moved to amend said bill by adping at the end of the first section thereof, the following:

Provided that nothing herein contained shall be taken or construed to prevent persons acting under the patrole laws of this State, or of the city of Baltimore from wearing the same during the hours of such patrole, or sheriffs and constables in the discharge of their duty.

Which was read.

Mr. Fooks, moved that the substitute and amendments be rejected,

Resolved in the affirmative
