So the bill passed.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, the house proceeded to consider the bill, reported by Mr. Ridgely, entitled, an act supplemental to an act, entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of Jane White, late of the city of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Richardson, the house was called, and the door-keeper sent for the absent members:
