the premises, after or at the same time with the appointment of a receiver, and after such apppointment, shall proceed with said bill as a general creditors bill for application of the assets of the pattnership, and regarding said assets as a trust fund for the benefit of the creditors of said partnership; but beside distribution of assets as aforesaid, the court may decree likewise against the general and special partners, or the general partners only, payment of the claims of the original plaintiffs in said cause, and of all other creditors who according to the course of the court in cases of creditor, bill shall have become parties to the bill in said cause."

Which was read

Mr. Carpenter, moved that the house adjourn,

Resolved in the affirmative.

The House accordingly adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
