Which was read and referred to Messro. Bowlus, Brengle

and Matthias.

The speaker laid before the house a report of the inspector of tobacco at warehouse No. 1, in the city of Baltimore, relative to the several sums of money paid by him into the Western Shore treasury within the year ending on the 30th of Nevember;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways

and means.

On motion of Mr. Maulsby, the house took up for consideration, the bill reported by him as chairman of the committee on insolvency, entitled, an act for the relief of Samuel Thompson, of the city of Baltimore,

The said bill was then read the second time and passed. The bill rep rted by Mr. Comegys, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors in the city and county of Baltimore, passed at December session 1816, chapter 221,

And, the bill reported by Mr. Harding, entitled, an act for the relief of Martha Riley, of Montgomery county,

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the se-

cond time, and severally passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Boyd, from the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Bomgardner, of Frederick county, from her husband, Henry Bomgardner, was taken up for consideration,

When on motion of Mr. Carpenter, said bill was ordered

to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Crisfield, from the committee on ways and means, entitled, an act to fix the salary of the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore, was taken up for consideration,

When ou motion of Mr. Alexander, said bill was order-

ed to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Alexander, chairman of the committee on ways and means, entitled, a supplement to the act, to incorporate the Farmer's and Planter's Bank of Baltimore, passed at December session 1835, chapter 315, was taken up for consideration,

On motion of Mr. Ridgely, said bill was recommitted.

Mr. Jump, by leave of the house, reported a bill, entitled, an act to authorise Thomas S. Carter, and William F. Chilton, of Caroline county, to alter and change a road therein named,
