And, the bill reported by Mr. Handy, entitled, an act to confirm an act, entitled, an act to provide for an alteration in the constitution so far as relates to the division of the 6th election district in Worcester county,

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the se-

cord time, passed and sent to the senate,

On motion of Mr. McLean, the house took up for consideration the bill reported by Mr. Boyd, from the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce Ehzabeth Harvey, of Baltimore city, from her husband Joseph Harvey;

Mr. Boyd, offered as a substitute for said bill, a bill, entitled, an act for the relief of Elizabeth Harvey, of the city

of Baltimore:

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time.

On the question being put, will the house adopt the substitute.

It was resolved in the affirmative.

The question was then put, shall the said bill pass?

Resolved in the affirmative, and The bill sent to the Senate.
