Which amendments were severally read the first, and by special order the second time and severally assented to.

Mr. McLean, chairman of the committee on corporations, reported the following bills with amendments, viz:

The bill reported by Mr. Perry, entitled, an act supplemental to an act to incorporate the Cumberland Hotel in Cumberland, reported with the following amendments;

Amendments proposed,

Strike out "same," in the 3d line of the 1st section, and the words "as is" in the same line;

Also, the words "as is" in the second line of the 2d section;

After the words "Cumberland Hotel company in Cumberland," in the 3d line of the 13th section, strike out the rest of the section, and insert, "but shall not commence building, or begin any other operation, until the sum of twenty five thousand dollars shall have been actually subscribed, and paid in current money."

Which were read,

The bill also, reported by Mr. Perry, entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from some point on the national turnpike road, west of Cumberland to intersect the north-western turnpike road, of Virginia, at some point in Allegany county, reported the same with the following amendments;

Amendments proposed,

In the first line of 1st section, strike out "Joseph Biggs," and insert "James Totton, Jr.;"

In the 2d line of 1st section, strike out "George W. Devicman," and insert "Henry Hammill;"

At the end of the 2d section, add "but the said company shall organize within two years according to the provisions, and requisitions of this act, and the whole of the capital subscribed, shall be paid in current money within one year thereafter;"

In the 5th line of 3d section, strike out "to," and insert "shall," and in the 6th line of same section, strike out "and shall be capable in law to have perpetual succession."

In the 1st line of 4th section, strike out "two," and insert "ten;"
