tion thereof the word "perpetual."

Mr. Eccleston moved further to amend said bill, by adding at the end thereof the following—"or at any earlier period, if in the exercise of the corporate powers hereby intended to be granted, the continuance of said corporation shall be found to conflict with, or be injurious to the general or individual interests of the citizens of this State, as guarantied to them by the constitution and laws thereof;"
