

The said bill was then read the second time, as amended, and passed.

On motion of Mr. Bruce,

The title of said bill was amended, by inserting after the word 'Hotel' the word 'company.'

On motion of Mr. Tuck,

The house took up for consideration the bill, entitled, an act to establish the Real Estate Bank of the State of Maryland, referred by the preceding to the succeeding session of the General Assembly.

On motion of Mr. Tuck,

Said bill was then referred to a select committee of seven, composed of Messrs. Tuck, Maulsby, Hood, Townsend, of Worcester, Ely, Ballard and Price.

Mr. Boyd submitted the following resolution—

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council be and they are hereby requested to forward to the Executives of the several States and Territories in the Union a copy of the annual report of the Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland, and to request of the said Executives a copy of the annual reports of their Treasurers, respectively; and that the said reports, when received, be deposited in the State Library;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, and assented to.

The amendments proposed by the Senate to the bill reported by Mr. Tuck, entitled, an act to change the terms of Prince George's county court,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

The resolution submitted by Mr. Crisfield, on the 30th ultimo, authorising the State Librarian to subscribe for two hundred copies of Band's Chancery Reports,

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Crisfield,

Said resolution was amended, by adding at the end thereof the following—'and the Librarian is hereby directed to dispose of said books in the same manner as the Reports of the Court of Appeals now are disposed of, and the balance to be kept in the Library.

Mr. McLean moved to lay said resolution on the table;

Determined in the negative.

Mr. McLean then moved to amend said resolution, by striking out 'two hundred,' and inserting in lieu thereof 'one hundred.'
