

On motion of Mr. McDaniel,

Said committee was enlarged, by adding thereto Messrs. McDaniel and Brengle.

The bill reported by Mr. McLean, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, entitled, an act relating to bills of exchange and promissory notes,

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. McLean,

Said bill was laid on the table, and made the order of the day for Monday next, the 6th inst.

The bill reported by Mr. Alexander, chairman of the committee on ways and means, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Farmers' and Planters' Bank of Baltimore, passed at December session, 1835, chapter 315,

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. McLean,

Said bill was amended, by striking out in the proviso to the last section thereof the words, "and be it further enacted."

The said bill was then read the second time, as amended, and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Alexander, chairman of the committee on ways and means, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Citizens' Bank, of Baltimore, passed at December session, 1835, chapter 314,

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Alexander, said bill was amended by striking out in the fourth section thereof, these words "or from any person or persons whatsoever."

On motion of Mr. Alexander, said bill was further amended by striking out in the proviso, in the last section of the bill, the words "and be it enacted."

Mr. Worthington moved to reconsider the fourth section of the bill for the purpose of amendment,

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Worthington, seconded by two other members that voted in the majority, the house reconsidered their vote upon the amendment first adopted to said bill, striking out in the 4th section thereof, the words "or from any person or persons whatsoever,"

The question was then again put, on striking out the words "or from any person or persons whatsoever"—and

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Worthington, said bill was further amended by striking out the proviso in the fourth section thereof,
