

Mr. Brengle, then moved to amend the third section of said bill by inserting after the word "times" in the sixth line thereof, these words "before the first day of April next, when the whole shall be demanded, if not paid before,"

Determined in the negative.

Mr. McLean, then moved to amend said section by inserting after the word "authorised," in the fifth line thereof, these words, "to deposit such portion or portions as he may think expedient with the Farmers' Bank of Maryland and," also by inserting in the same line after the word "thereof," these words, "from the said several Banks or either of them,"

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Richardson then moved to amend said section, by striking out in the tenth line from the word "same," to the end thereof, and inscribing in lieu thereof the following :

"In such banking institutions chartered by the State, as shall secure to the State the best interest upon the same;"

Determined in the negative.
