The question then recurred upon the passage of the bill; Mr. Donoho, moved to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following,

Section 2nd. And be it enacted, that so much of the act passed December session 1831, chapter 323, also the supplement of December session 1833, chapter 87, as relates to the introduction of slaves into this State, are hereby repealed, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
