So the amendment was rejected.

Mr. Brengle then moved to amend said section by inserting after the word "he" in the fifth line thereof, the following:

"Shall place the same to the credit of the State, in said Banks, and the Farmers Bank of Maryland, in sums proportionate to their capital, until the first day of April next;"

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Culbreth, then moved to amend said section, by striking out from the word "thereof" in the fifth line, to the end of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof, the following:

"And whenever any sum or sums of money aforesaid, shall be paid to the Treasurer, it shall be his duty to deposite the same in the Union Bank of Maryland—Franklin Bank of Baltimore, and Farmers Bank of Maryland, in the following proportions:—not less than one quarter, nor more than two fifth parts thereof in the Farmers Bank of Maryland, and the residue in the Union Bank of Maryland, and Franklin Bank of Baltimore in such proportions as to the Treasurer may seem proper, the whole to be held by said Banks, subject to the control of the General Assembly.

Which was read,

Mr. Tuck, moved to amend said amendment, by inserting after the words "Franklin Bank of Baltimore," the words "Bank of Baltimore."

Determined in the Negative,

The question then recurred, and was put upon the amendment, as offered by Mr. Culbreth:

Resolved in the affirmative.
