

tain the records belonging to the officers of the Court of Appeals, and Court of Chancery, the Land office and the office of the Clerk to the Executive Council.

2d. Resolved that the aforesaid building be erected and furnished under the direction of some suitable person or persons, to be appointed by the Governor and Council, who are hereby strictly prohibited from entering into any contracts for the aforesaid purpose, which may require any further appropriation for the completion or fulfilment thereof, and that the aforesaid sum of money or so much thereof, as may be necessary for the aforesaid purpose, shall be paid on the order of the Governor and Council, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

3d. Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the sums of money herein after mentioned, be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the purposes following—that is to say, the sum of five hundred dollars for procuring desks and chairs for six additional Delegates, for purchasing a carpet for the chamber of the House of Delegates, and for painting the said chamber and its adjacent committee room and other necessary repairs therein.

The sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, for repairing the chamber commonly called the Old Armory, and furnishing the same as a committee room, for the use of the House of Delegates.

The sum of eight hundred dollars for repairing and refurnishing the chamber used for the sittings of the Court of Appeals and court of Chancery, the sum of two hundred dollars for repairing the Library chamber, and the sum one hundred dollars, for repairing the Chancery office, the Adjutant General's office, Land office and other offices in the State House.

The sum of one thousand dollars, for painting the exterior of the State House, and repairing the Dome thereof.

The sum of three hundred dollars for building a Wood house, and the sum of three hundred dollars, for improving the grounds within the public circle.

4 h. Resolved, that the repairs and improvements hereby authorized to be made under the direction of some suitable person or persons, to be appointed by the Governor and Council, and the said persons are hereby strictly prohibited in making contracts for the same for exceeding the appropriations hereby made for the same purposes respectively, and the said sums of money hereby appropriated or so much thereof as shall be necessary for the aforesaid purposes, shall
