Also the bill entitled, an act to prohibit the owners of vessels and others from navigating the same by and under the sole command of negroes and mulattoes; endorsed 'proposed amendment to the amendment of the Senate assented to,' and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

Also the bill entitled, an act to regulate the manner of taking testimony in cases in equity; endorsed 'amendment to first amendment of the Senate assented to, and the second amendment of the Senate receded from,' and the bill-

ordered to be engrossed;

Also the bill entitled, an act to ascertain the allowance of the sherift of Somerset county for keeping prisoners in jail, and to provide for the maintenance of debtors actually confined in prison, endorsed 'will pass with the proposed amendments;

Which amendments were severally read the first time,

and ordered to lie on the table.

Also the resolution in favor of William H. Fitzbugh;
Also the resolution in favor of the securities of Samuel
Warnick, of Allegany county;

Also the resolution authorising Capt. Henry McKinnell

to take possession of six pieces of artillery, &c.;

And the resolution relating to a fire-proof magazine; Severally endorsed 'assented to,' and the resolutions ordered to be engrossed;

Also the resolution in favor of Joseph Ennalls, of Dorchester county, endorsed 'assented to with the proposed a-

mendment;

Which amendment was read the first and by special order the second time, assented to, and ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, an act to establish a line between Carroll and Baltimore counties;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Matthias, Wor-

thington and Ely;

And a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Thomas Golden; Which was read, and referred to the committee on insolvency.

And a communication from his Excellency Governor Veazey, endorsed 'referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates,' and is as follows—

Gentlemen of the Senate, and of the House of Delegates,

We submit for your consideration, a communication
