Mr. Palmer moved to amend said bill by striking out in the first section, fourteenth line, these words 'or places to be mentioned in the said mortgage,'

Determined in the negative. On motion of Mr. Worthington,

Said bill was amended by striking out in the first sec-

tion, the proviso in said section.

Mr. Worthington moved further to amend said bill by striking out in the third section thereof, in the fifth line, these words 'unless some other place shall be agreed between the parties of said mortgage,' and inserting in lieu thereof, the following, 'at the residence or place of abode of the mortgager, or at the Court-house of the county where such mortgage is recorded;'

Determined in the negative. On motion of Mr. Brengle,

Said bill was amended by inserting after the word 'mortgage,' in the third section, sixth line, the following,

'Either at the time of the execution of the mortgage or afterwards, which said agreement shall and may be recorded, together with the deed of conveyance from the mortgagor to the purchaser.'

On motion of Mr. Handy,

Said bill was further amended by inserting after the word 'time,' in the fifth section, second line, these words 'for not less than three weeks at any one time.'

On motion of Mr. Worthington,

Said section was further amended by inserting after the word 'postponed,' in the fifth line, the following,

'And if there be no newspaper published in the county where such mortgaged property lie, then, and in that case, such notice of postponement shall be set up at the Court-house door of said county, and a copy thereof left at the house or last place of abode of the mortgagors, and another copy thereof, shall be filed with the clerk of the county, and recorded by him as hereinbefore provided.'

The house suspended the further consideration of the said bill, for the purpose of receiving a message from the

Senate.
