Mr. Shaw moved to amend said amendment, by inserting as the 11th section thereof, the following—

'Sec. 11. Be it enacted, that the ratio of representation and the minimum and maximum of representation for the several counties in this State, established by this bill, shall not at any time hereafter be altered or changed unless a bill so to alter and change the same, shall be passed by two-thirds of both branches of the Legislature, and shall be published at least three months before a new election of delegates, and shall be confirmed by a vote of two-thirds of the members of each branch of the General Assembly at the next regular session thereafter.'

Mr. Richardson moved to amend said amendment, by inserting in the 13th section, after the word 'council,' in the 2d line, the following, 'and which gives to the Governor the power to grant a nolle prosequi;'

Mr. Simmons moved to amend the 20th section of said amendment, by 'striking out 'January,' in the 8th line, and inserting 'March;'

Mr. Kerr moved to amend said 20th section, by striking out from the word 'the,' in the 18th line, to the end of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'State;'
