Also the bill entitled, an act for building a bridge over Deer creek, at or near William Pyle's saw mill, in Harford county;

Also the bill entitled, an act to widen part of Waggon

alley, in the city of Baltimore;

Also the bill entitled, an act to build a bridge over the Great Gunpowder Falls, where the county road leading from Middletown to the Falls road crosses said falls in Baltimore county;

And the bill entitled, an act to limit the sitting of the

commissioners of the tax in Worcester county;

Severally endorsed 'will pass,' and severally ordered'

to be engrossed.

Also the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the protection of cysters in the waters of the Eastern Shore of this State, passed at December session 1831, ch. 249, so far as relates to the waters bordering on Queen Ann's county; endorsed 'will pass with the proposed amendment;'

Which amendment was read the first, and by special order the second time, assented to and the bill ordered

to be engrossed;

Also the bill entitled, an act to build a bridge in Baltimore county, over the White Marsh Run, at or near the head of Bird's river; endorsed 'amendment assented to,' and the bill ordered to be engrossed:

And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise James M. Selden, of Baltimore county, to bring into this State the several

slaves therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the committee on

coloured population.

And a bill entitled, an set to regulate the charges for the use of backney carriages in the city of Baltimore;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Boyd submitted the following resolution-

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Governor, by and with the consent of the Council, is hereby requested to appoint a suitable person to compile the constitution of this State, including the amendments proposed at the present session, and omitting those parts repealed, or proposed to be repealed, and have the same published with the laws of this session; and that the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised to draw on the treasurer for any sum not exceeding
