On motion of Mr. Handy,

Said bill was referred to the committee on corporations.

On motion of Mr. Powell,

Mr. Worthington, from the committee on coloured population, to which was referred the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise James M. Selden, of Baltimore county, to bring into this State the several slaves therein named, reported the same without amendment;

The said bill was then read the first, and by special order the second time, and passed.

Mr. Bruce reported a bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act to incorporate the Maryland Mining Company;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Handy,

The house took up for consideration the bill from the Senate, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Buckingham academy, in Worcester county, passed at December session 1813, ch. 13;

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.

On motion of Kershner,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by him entitled, an act relating to the German Reform Parsonage in the town of Hagerstown, Washington county;

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.

Mr. Brengle reported a bill entitled, an act relating to pensioners by county assessment, in Carroll county;

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and passed.
