

At the end of the 3rd section, add the following proviso,

'Provided that the said corporation shall not at any time have or hold real property to a value exceeding the sum of ten thousand dollars,'

Which were read and assented to.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, by special order, and passed.

On motion of Mr. Ridgely,

The house took up for consideration the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to appoint commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Savage village, in Anne Arundel county.

On motion of Mr. Ridgely,

Said bill was recommitted.

Mr. Brengle reported a bill, entitled, an act to repeal an act, for the dispatch of business in Frederick county Court, passed December session 1829, and its supplements;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Shaw, from the committee on corporations, to which was referred the bill reported by Mr. Richardson, entitled, an act to incorporate the 'Order of United Brothers of Baltimore,' reported the same with the following amendments,

Amendments proposed;

In the sixth line of 3rd section, strike out 'thirty' and insert 'ten,'

Strike out the 7th section in the bill;

Which were read.

Mr. Worthington, from the select committee, to which was referred the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to abolish the board of commissioners for Baltimore county, and vest their powers and duties in a Levy Court, reported unfavorably thereon;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Townsend, of Worcester, entitled, an act to provide for building a bridge over Dividing creek, at a place called Denston's dams, on the public road leading from Princess Anne in Somerset county, to Snowhill, in Worcester county;

Was taken up for consideration.
