Also the resolution relating to the donation to Lower Marlborough academy, in Calvert county, endorsed 'dissented from?'

Ordered, that 500 copies of the report of the joint committee on St. John's college, be printed for the use of this house;

Which was read.

On motion of Mr. Gough,

Said order was amended, by striking out '500' and inserting '111.'

The said order was then read the second time as amended, and adopted.

Mr. Rigely, from the select committee, to which was re-committed the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to appoint commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Savageville, in Anne Arundel county, reported the same with the following amendments;

#### Amendments proposed.

Strike out in the 1st section, 11th line, 'and to make such other ordinances and regulations as shall be necessary for levying and collecting annually a tax of five dollars on every dog, and ten dollars on every slut within the limits of said town, and to kill any dog or slut whose owner cannot be ascertained.'

Strike out the 9th section.
