said county or counties, shall revert to the general treasury of the State, and be subject in all respects to the

future action of the Legislature.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, that the amount held in trust for said county or county or counties, and the interest accruing semi-annually thereon, shall be invested by the treasurer of the Wsstern Shore in some safe and profitable stock, producing not less than an interest of five per centum per annum, and the said treasurer is hereby authorised to remove said fund from one investment to another, whenever and as often as he may think proper for the security of the same.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, that the Governor and Council cause this act to be published in one newspaper in each county of the State and in the city of Baltimore, at least six weeks before the first Monday in October next, and the commissioners of tax or levy court in each county shall cause the said act to be put up for the information of the people, at such public places in each election district of each county, as they may think proper.

Which was read.

Mr. Tuck called for a division of the question, which was put on striking out, and

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Hood then moved that said bill be rejected;

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred, and was put, shall the said bill pass?
