it is based on a new lottery grant, which the committee would deem impolitic, and demoralising to the community. In addition to this consideration, the committee are of opinion that the scheme proposed would enrich the petitioner without any corresponding benefit of the State, so far from rendering an equivolent for the advantages he asks the services of the youths altuded to in culture of silk would be it is supposed quite equal to their maintenance and education. The consequence would be that Mr. Davis would at the expi tion of ten years have gained by the munificence of the State an immensely profitable estate, without any o her advantage than that which is derived from witnessing the prosperity of his establishment to the citizens at large of the State. The committee believe his scheme is a handsome private speculation, but they can perceive in it no benefit of a character which should entitle it to the patronage of the State, they therefore report unfa-Aoutably on Mr. Davis' petition and beg to be discharged from the further consideration of the subject.
