Also the bill entitled, an act to authorise the clerk of Anne Arundel county court to record certain deeds therein mentioned, and to make said deeds valid;

A so the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act to authorise the appointment of justices of the prace in the

city of Baltimore, with limited jurisdiction;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to authorise the conveyance of a certain lot of ground near Clear Spring, in Washing-

on county; endorsed, "will not pass."

And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled a supplement to the act entitled, an act to regulate the compensation of jurors, judges of the orphan's court, judges of the levy court, commissioners of the tax, and witnesses, for Caroline county, passed at December session 1834, ch 208;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Carter, Jump

and Nicols;

And, a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to establish a Bank, and incorporate a company, under the name of the Washington county Bank, at the town of Wilhamsport in Washington County, passed at December session 1831, chap 133.

Which was read, and referred to the committee on ways

and means.
