

Mr. Harris reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act for the preservation of wild towl in the Potomac river and its tributary streams, passed at December session, 1832, chapter 134;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time;

On motion of Mr. Hopewell,

Said bill was amended, by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following: "And be it enacted, That this act, and the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, be, and the same is hereby extended to the Patuxent river;"

Mr. Brengle moved to lay said bill on the table;

Resolved in the affirmative.

The bill reported by Mr. McLean, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Merchants' Fire Insurance company of Baltimore, was taken up for consideration;

The said bill was then read the second time, and placed in the hands of the Speaker;

Mr. Buchanan moved to withdraw said bill from hands of the chair;

Determined in the negative.

The question was then put, shall the said bill pass?

Resolved in the affirmative.
