And, the bill, entitled, an act for the revaluation of the real and personal property in Charles county,

Were sent to the senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to confirm an act, entitled, an act to alter and amend the constitution and form of government of this State, so far as it relates to the representation in the House of Delegates, from the city of Baltimore,

Was returned to the senate.

The Speaker laid before the house a report from the Register in Chancery, shewing the amount of seals and taxes accruing on proceedings in his office, and collectable by the Sheriffs in the several counties in this State, for the present year,

Also, laid before the house a report from the Clerk of Calvert county, relative to the several sums of money paid by him into the Western Shore Treasury, within the year

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on ways and means

The Speaker also laid before the house a report from the Clerk of Calvert county, relative to the attendance of Judges,

Which was read and referred to the committee on griev-

ances and courts of justice.

Mr. Perry, presented a petition of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying the passage of an act, incorporating a Bank to be called "The Union Bank of Allegany,"

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways

and means.

Mr. Boyd, obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, an act for the suppression of fraud in the management of Banks in this State,

Ordered, that Messrs. Boyd, Ely and Brengle, report the

same.
