

Mr. Iglehart, submitted the following resolution;

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to George G. Brewer, chief clerk of the house of delegates, and Joseph H. Nicholson, chief clerk of the senate, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, the amount of the several accounts that may from time to time, be presented to them by said clerks, for newspapers furnished by them for the use of the members of their respective houses in accordance with an order adopted by said house for that purpose.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, assented to, and sent to the senate,

Mr. Iglehart, chairman of the committee on claims, made an unfavourable report upon the memorial of Fielder Hays, of Prince George's county, praying to have certain caution money paid by him into the treasury refunded;

Also, an unfavourable report upon the memorial of James D. Woodside, praying remuneration for services therein named;

Which reports were severally read the first and by special order the second time and concurred in.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, an act to authorise the clerk of Kent county Court, to record a certain instrument of writing therein mentioned, and to make the same valid, endorsed 'will pass,' and ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill, entitled, an additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company, endorsed 'will not pass;'

Also, the bill, entitled, an act to repeal so much of the act to limit and define the jurisdiction of justices of the peace, passed at December session 1834, as relates to Baltimore county, endorsed 'considered, and will not pass;'

And, delivered a communication from the Executive, endorsed 'referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates, and is as follows,
