

county, to condemn a lot of land for the purpose of making a causeway or dam over the narrows at Eastern Neck Island, and to appoint commissioners to make or contract for the making of said dam or causeway over the said narrows at or near the place where the bridge crosses the said narrows in the county aforesaid,

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Alexander, entitled, an act relating to appeals;

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. McLean,

Said bill was amended by striking out the third section thereof;

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, passed, and sent to the Senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to limit the sessions of the General Assembly in every alternate year, was taken up for consideration;

Mr. Carpenter, moved that said bill be rejected;

Resolved in the affirmative.

And the bill returned to the senate.

The bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise and direct the levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money for the enlargement and repair of the court house in said county, was taken up for consideration;

Mr. Brengle, moved that said bill be rejected;

Resolved in the affirmative.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act supplemental to the act, entitled, an act to establish magistrates courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, passed at December session 1835, chap. 201, and the amendment reported thereto from the select committee, was taken up for consideration;

The amendment having been read the second time was assented to;

The said bill was then read the second time, passed with the proposed amendments, and returned to the Senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to confirm an act, entitled; an act to repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government, as relates to the division of Cecil county, into four separate election districts;
