

And, the bill reported by Mr. Brengle, entitled, an act to prevent private bankers from issuing notes in the shape of bank notes;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and referred to the consideration of the next General Assembly.

Mr. Bruce submitted the following message,

Which was read and assented to, and sent to the senate.

By the House of Delegates,
March 20, 1837.

Gentlemen of the Senate.

We have received your message proposing a joint committee to wait upon his Excellency, the Governor, and invite him to attend in the Senate Chamber, for the purpose of signing the laws that have passed during the present session of the Legislature, and concur therein, and have appointed Messrs. Bruce and Taylor, on the part of this house for that purpose.

The bill reported by Mr. Comegys, entitled, an act relating to guardians and wards;

And, the bill reported by Mr. Usilton, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries, and for other purposes, passed at December session 1827;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, and severally rejected.

The bill reported by Mr. Hemsley, entitled, an act to exempt the property of all institutions for the promotion of Education, incorporated by this State from the payment of tax, was taken up for consideration.

Mr. Boyd, moved that said bill be rejected,

Determined in the negative.

The said bill was then read the second time and passed, and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Kershner, from the committee on ways and means, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Hagerstown Bank;

Also, the bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act concerning crimes and punishments, passed December session 1835, ch. 200;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Crisfield, from the committee on ways and means, entitled, an act to provide additional
