

Also, the bill reported by Mr. Duke, chairman of the committee on pensions by county assessment, entitled, an act for the relief of sundry poor persons in the several counties therein mentioned;

And, the bill reported by Mr. Brengle, entitled, an act to incorporate Woodsboro in Frederick county;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to abolish the board of commissioners for Baltimore county, and vest their powers and duties in the levy court, was taken up for consideration;

And the unfavourable report of the committee made thereon recommending the rejection of said bill;

On the question being put, will the house concur in the report of the committee, and reject the bill;

It was determined in the negative.
