The committee on the coloured population, to whom were referred two communications from Joseph Husband, of Harlord county, on the subject of slavery in this State, have had the same under consideration, and beg leave to report, that it is inexpedient and unnecessary to legislate upon the subject of those communications; they therefore pray to be discharged from their further consideration.
