Resolved, that all expenses which may be incurred in virtue of the foregoing resolutions, shall be payable out of any unappropriated money in the treasury,

Strike out the word "twenty" and insert "ten" in the 10th line of the 3rd section.

Insert as section 11th, And be it enacted, that if at any time the debts of the said company shall exceed the sum of five thousand dollars, any president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, steward, or messenger, who shall appear to have assented thereto, shall be personally liable for the same, if the funds or property of the said company shall not be found sufficient for the payment thereof,
