In the 14th line of 4th section, strike out 'necessary' and

insert 'thirty days.'

Insert as additional sections, And be it enacted, that the said company shall not be organized or commence any man ufacture whatever, before twenty-five thousand dollars shall have been subscribed to the capital stock, and actually paid in current money, nor unless that sum shall be subscribed and paid in within three years from the passage of this act:

And be it enacted, that nothing in this act shall be construed to authorise the said company to exercise banking privileges or to issue any note in the nature of a bank note;

And be it enacted, that this act shall be in force only until the year eighteen hundred and fifty seven, and the next General Assembly which shall happen thereafter,

Mr. McLean, chairman of the committee no corporations, to which was referred the bill reported by Mr. Ridgely, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Bank of Maryland, reported the same with the following amendment,

Amendments proposed,

After the word 'supplement' in the last line of the 2nd section, insert the fsllowing words, 'but the said weekly deposits shall be payable on demand, with interest thereon, at the rate of four per centum per annum,'

Mi.
