Mr. Briscoe submitted the following amendment:

Sec. 42. That any porson or persons possessed of any slave or slaves within this State, or any executor, administrator or guardian, may by writing under his her or their hand and seal evidenced by at least two good and sufficient witnesses and acknowledged before a Justice of the Peace of the county, where the grantors reside and recorded in the office of the clerk of the circuit court for said county, within thirty days from its date, by said instrument or last will and testament executed to pass personal property and duly admitted to probate grant to such slave or slaves his, her or their freedom, and that a copy of such record duly attested under the seal of said office where said deed or last will and testament may be recorded, shall be good and sufficient evidence to prove such freedom in all cases where such slave or slaves shall have been enlisted in the military service of the United States to enable said person or persons, executor, administrator or guardian, to recover compensation for said slave or slaves, and all deeds of manumission so executed shall be valid and effectual to all intents
