Leave was granted Messrs. Campbell, Kemp and Crane, to report a bill to legalize a bequest made by Jacob Landis, late of Carroll county, deceased, to the church of Ascension in Westminster ; and also, a bequest made by the same to the vestry building committee of the new Episcopal church or chapel in Uniontown, Md.

Mr. Eichelberger from the committee on Judicial Proceedings reported a bill, entitled, "An Act to repeal sections 42 and 43 of Article 66 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to manumission ;"

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Tome,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to report a bill to renew the charter of the Columbia and Port Deposit Railroad company and for other purposes.
