The President announced the following committee:

*Committee on Federal Relations.*—Messrs. Ricaud, Eichelberger, Ohr, Crane and Jenkins.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Female Samaritan Society of Lutheran church, in Hagerstown;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, "An Act to revive and amend the act of incorporation of the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, passed December session, 1823, chapter 125, with the several supplements thereto;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, "An Act to incorporate the Little Meadows Spring Company;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled, "An Act to refund to Charles Shipley taxes erroneously paid, amounting to fifty-nine dollars and ninety-five cents;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the Finance,

A bill entitled, "An Act to provide for the repair or re-building of the county jail of Prince Georges' county;"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bayne, Rowles and Ohr.

A bill entitled, "An Act to allow William H. Protzman, administrator of Joseph G. Protzman, late of Washington county, deceased, further time to complete his collections;"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Firey, Ohr and Willis.

A bill entitled, "An Act to allow Henry Gantz, State collector of State and county taxes in Washington county, for the years 1858 and '59, further time to complete his collections;"

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.
