Mr. Eichelberger, from the committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported a bill entitled, "An Act to amend the 37th article of the Public General Laws, by repealing the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, and 5th sections of said article, relating to the competency of witnesses and the examination of parties ;

Which was read the first time, and made the Order of the Day for Tuesday, January 26, and ordered to be printed.

Also, reported a bill entitled, "An Act to dismiss the writ of error taken by the State in the case of Myers vs. the State of Pennsylvania, and to pay the counsel employed by the Governor to conduct said case ;"
