The President laid before the Senate a communication from the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike Company ;

Leave was granted the committee on Finance to report a bill to compensate Neilson Poe for legal services on the employment of the Governor.

Mr. Eichelberger, from the committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported a bill entitled, "An Act to make valid the devise made in the last will of Christianna Schall, late of Frederick county, deceased, to the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Frederick, in Frederick city, Maryland ;"
