At which said next Court to witt the twenty first day of August and Dow. One thousand Seven  
 hundred and thirty three came again as well the said Amos Woodward as the said Nathaniel Watson by their  
 attorneys of and whereupon the same Nathaniel prays further Leave thereof to Imparl here until  
 next Court and he hath it and the Same day is given to the said Amos here also &c.

At which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of November and Dow. One thousand Seven hund  
 red and thirty three and ~~thirteen~~ <sup>thirteen</sup> ~~hundred~~ <sup>hundred</sup> and thirty three came again as well the said  
 Amos Woodward as the said Nathaniel Watson by their attorneys of and because the said Amos did  
 not declare against the said Nathaniel in the plea of nor prosecute his writ of against the said Nathaniel

 Nathaniel go thereof without day also it is considered that the said Nathaniel Watson Recover against
