At which said next Court to w^{it} the twentieth day of November and did One thousand Seven hundred & thirty three came againe as w^{ell} the s^d James Brennan as the s^d Thomas Billini by their attorney s^d. and because the s^d James did not declare against the s^d Thomas in the plea s^d nor did prosecute his w^{it} s^d against the same Thomas &c

Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting be in mercy and the s^d name pledges &c and that the s^d Thomas Billini go thereof without day also it is considered that the s^d Thomas Billini recover against the s^d James Brennan his damages by Omission of the premises to Two hundred & thirty four pounds of tobacco to the same Thomas Billini by direction of the Justices here at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute therof & they made and provided as judged &c

memorand. the said writ should have been Entered immediately after the return of the writ but was omitted and Entered here as followeth vid. Whereupon the s^d Thomas Billings being called appears and thereupon the said Thomas Billini at the prayer of the s^d James Brennan by his attorney s^d is adjudged to give special bail to the action s^d thereupon certain John Britt of Somerset County planter present here in Court undertook for the said Tho. Billini and assumed upon himselfe that if in case the said James Brennan should recover Judgment in the plea s^d or that the said Thomas Billini should be Honorii Condemn that then he the said Thomas Billini should pay the Condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body to the Custody of the s^d of Somerset County in Satis fashion therof or that he the said John Britt will do the same for him &c

1705 Adam Muir Comment was given to the s^d of Somerset County that he should take Walter Jacobs late of Somerset County Joyner and Eliza his wife lately called Elizabeth Dashiell late of Somerset County Administratrix of all and singular the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of Christopher Dashiell at the time of his Death and therein to keep so that he might have their body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to answer unto Adam Muir of a plea that they Render unto him the sum of twenty eight pounds One Shilling & three pence three farthings [to be paid in Stavespork and Indian corn] and four hundred and thirty nine pounds of tobacco which to him they owe and unjustly detain &c and that therof he should not fail &c

At which said third Tuesday of March to w^{it} the twentieth day of the same month and did One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two being the day of the return of the said Writ Cometh the said Adam Muir by William Buntingham his attorney and the s^d of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Comes and makes return thereof
